

Cyngor Cymuned Tregynon Community Council

Minutes of Tregynon Community Council's meeting held on 14 July 2022 at 7.30 pm in the community centre following the Wind Farm Trust meeting.

Present: Cllrs J. Shearer, S. Williams, D. Bumford, M. Davies, W. Jones and clerk R. Jones. Cllr Jones handed in a playground inspection sheet. *Apologies:* Received from Cllr Hulme and Cllr Watkin.

Declarations of interest: None at this time.

Minutes: The councillors reviewed and accepted the minutes of the June meeting The Chair then signed the minutes.

Matters arising: None.

Planning: 22/0760/RES (Application for reserved matters following the approval of 3 affordable dwellings on land adjacent to Llys Cynon). The councillors decided to reiterate their comments sent in previously.

Applications received after distribution of the agenda, at the discretion of the Chair: None

Highways: The flashing sign is working well. The Rosemary Drive alley will be discussed at the September meeting. The councillors noted a very bad pothole outside Fingerpost Farm. Clerk to report this to Highways.

Playground and amenity land: The spring equipment has been removed and the area is looking good. Quotes obtained by Cllr Hulme were perused and discussed. It was proposed, seconded and agreed unanimously that two benches be purchased and installed. A revised quote from Hamer for the groundworks will therefore be needed. Cllrs Davies, Williams and Jacques agreed to visit the site and chose the locations.

Defibrillator: A new case for the equipment is needed and was purchased online during the course of this evening's meeting. Councillor Jones to be reimbursed for the amount.

Finance: Current account- £11579.08; Reserve- £6864.43. The clerk had earlier distributed a bi-monthly reconciliation, and this was accepted. Invoice: One invoice was approved: Morgan Griffiths (payroll) £60.00. The Chair and Cllr Breese signed the cheque. The clerk distributed a spreadsheet showing the amount spent on playground equipment since 2014. This amount was £23,951.96. The amount spent on fence repairs around the playground was £9,083.00.

External reports: Cllr Hulme had earlier circulated a report of county council activities. Cllr Breese reported that the Cefn Twlch charities will hold a meeting next month.
